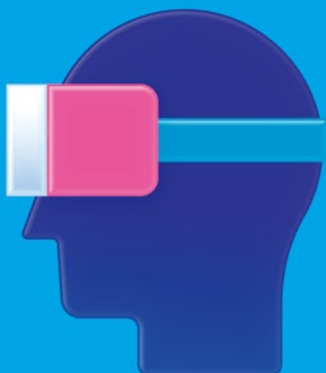




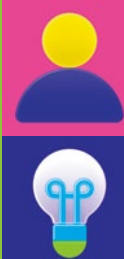

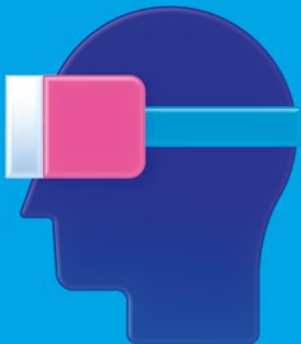

Digital Convergence at Kaohsiung Harbor, Riding the Next Wave of Culture and Technology

Every October, the Ministry of Culture and Kaohsiung jointly host the Taiwan Technology × Culture Expo (TTXC), transforming the city into an immersive platform for culture and technology. Through a diverse range of programs including themed exhibitions, international forums, industry exchanges, workshops, film screenings, immersive experiences, and performances, TTXC builds on Taiwan's strong technological and industrial foundations to deepen the value of local culture and bring technology into cultural creation. It serves as an international platform for exchange in culture and technology while showcasing Taiwan's growing strengths and capabilities in the cultural technology sector to the world.

Under the theme “All In AI,” TTXC 2026 will feature six themed conceptual exhibitions, six Future Exhibitions, twenty-five International Forums, one hundred immersive audiovisual works, and more than one hundred industry matchmaking sessions, visits, dialogues, and related activities. This year's featured exhibition, “Yes, AI Do.,” takes the form of an AI co-creation experience exhibition exploring the topic of virtual companionship, broadening the discussion to encompass the social issues surrounding how technology is shaping the development of human life. For the first time, TTXC will also collaborate with an international festival of culture, technology, and art, joining forces with MUTEK, the renowned festival from Montréal, Canada, to present an exciting program under the theme “Let's Play!” The event will also showcase the Kaohsiung City Government's achievements in actively supporting the virtual production industry. More than one hundred industry exchange activities will be held to foster connections between Taiwan and international cultural technology sectors, as well as innovative film, audiovisual, and music industries. By integrating resources from the Taiwan Creative Content Agency, matchmaking sessions will bring together investors and industry professionals from around the world to promote cultural technology works centered on Taiwanese content. Through these efforts, TTXC continues to enhance the international visibility and industry value of Taiwan's cultural technology sector, deepen Taiwan's core cultural values, support local creators and businesses in integrating technology into cultural creation, and gradually build an emerging ecosystem for culture and technology.

TTXC 2026 invites everyone to go “All In AI”! Together, we will build an AI dimension uniquely shaped by Taiwan and usher in an era of intelligent coexistence toward a world of shared prosperity.

Nezha Conquers the Dragon

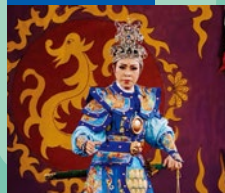

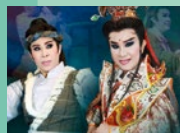

Field Report #001

TAIKANG | Shinji Nishikawa (Japan)

Sighting Location | Around the Great Harbor Bridge

"TAIKANG" was born before the Great Harbor Bridge, opening up a vision of the city's future. The work depicts a team of small mechanical monsters working together to assemble a colossal steel beast piece by piece around the bridge. TAIKANG is a mechanical life-form built by the city itself and born to protect it, symbolizing Kaohsiung's industrial technology, manufacturing prowess, and creative spirit.



Field Report #002

TAMA | KCN (Taiwan)

Sighting Location | Hamasen Railway Cultural Park

"TAMA" inhabits the Hamasen Railway Cultural Park, carrying the memories of the land. KCN intertwines childhood imaginings of monsters with Taiwan's history to create a two-headed guardian beast. According to the story, TAMA was brought back to Taiwan and raised by a Taiwanese soldier who had served in the Japanese military. After the soldier passed away, TAMA remained on this land, continuing to watch over the city as it changes through the ages.

Hamasen Railway Cultural Park

Hamasen Railway Cultural Park is a popular destination on weekends and holidays, where visitors can enjoy sightseeing, relaxing, and taking photos. One of the park's highlights is its collection of vintage trains, sourced from across Taiwan and meticulously restored. More than 30 retired trains, once used for transporting passengers and goods or serving specific industrial purposes, are showcased in the park, recreating the bustling railway operations that once characterized the Hamasen Railway.

Coastline Sightseeing Train "Hamasen Express / SL Hamasen Express"

One of the park's most popular experiences is riding the coastline sightseeing train, the "Hamasen Express / SL Hamasen Express," which bridges the past and present of Hamasen. Operating on Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays, the train passes by sites like the Old Takao Station Platform, the park's pedestrian bridge, the North Signal Tower, and the Kaohsiung Harbor Inspection Subsection, taking passengers on a journey through the century-long history of the Hamasen Railway. The History of Kaohsiung

Location: Exhibition Room 101-104

As a historical landmark, the Kaohsiung Museum of History becomes an important entrance for the public to learn about Kaohsiung. Following the “Impression of Kaohsiung” technological narrative in 2020, the key to Kaohsiung’s urban development was focused on in early 2022 through three themes: walking along the “river” to see the origin of Kaohsiung civilization; taking the “railway” to understand the industrial development and modernization of Kaohsiung; viewing the “harbor” construction to know how Kaohsiung connects with the world. The exhibition hall transforms into a landscape space, tracing Kaohsiung’s history from a traditional settlement to an international port city.

An Aesthetic Revolution That Transforms the Way We See the Everyday Rethinking the Familiar World Through Line and Color

This October, the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts exclusively presents *Michael Craig-Martin: The Language of the Everyday*, a ticketed special exhibition by renowned British artist Michael Craig-Martin. Emerging as a prominent figure in the late 1960s, Craig-Martin has built his practice around everyday objects, examining familiar things in modern life through highly symbolic colors and lines. His distinctive approach has had a profound influence on contemporary art, design, and visual culture. Following his 2024 retrospective at the Royal Academy of Arts in the UK, this exhibition marks Craig-Martin's first major solo exhibition in Asia. Featuring more than 70 works, including newly unveiled pieces, large-scale outdoor sculptures, and digital installations, the exhibition invites visitors to step into the galleries and rediscover the details of contemporary life through a new lens.
